KIDS for the BAY will bring the San Francisco Bay estuary into your classroom! Our program provides handson science experiments, animal and plant investigations, and activities that are aligned with Next Generation Science Standards. It includes three hours of instruction and a Teacher Activity Package.

BAY ESTUARY SCIENTISTS (GRADES 1–6)

- Create a three-dimensional bay estuary model.
- Experiment with fresh water and salt water to discover the unique properties of an estuary.
- Find your place in the San Francisco Bay Area using large, full color maps.
- Study bay food chains and investigate animals and plants that live in the Bay, including fish, crabs, and seaweed.
- Learn about opportunities to help protect and restore your local watershed.
