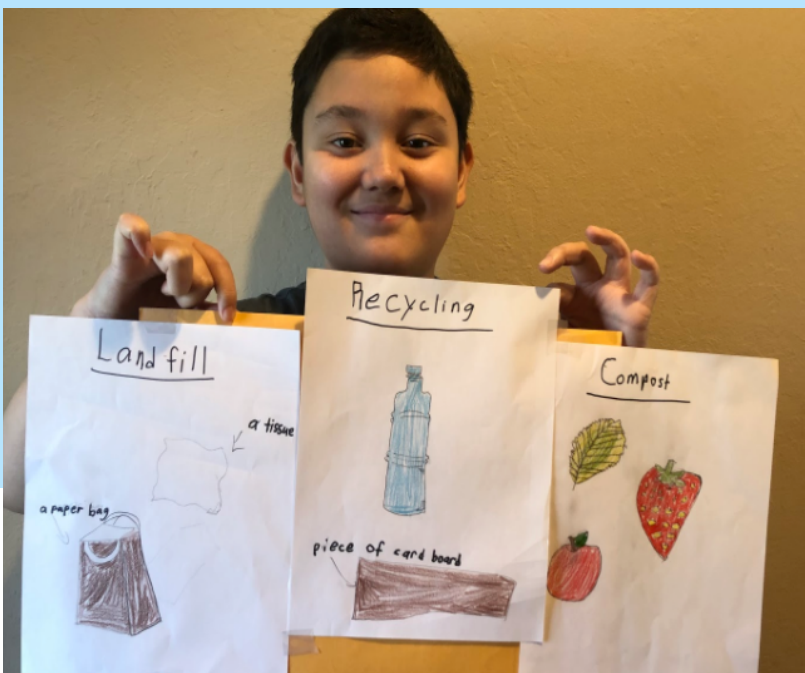

Storm Drain Rangers 2020-2021 Year in Review

In the 2020-2021 School Year:

- 419 students educated their communities about reducing storm drain pollution
- Student Environmentalists cleaned up 7,592 pieces of trash (152 gallons) from their local neighborhoods
- 419 students pledged to reduce water usage and help relieve California's drought
- Over 400 families engaged in interviews about storm drain pollution prevention with their students
