KIDS for the BAY will engage students in taking action to reduce storm drain pollution, showing how everyone can make a difference. This program provides a fun and educational opportunity for students to become leaders in their school communities.

The Storm Drain Rangers Program is also a teacher training opportunity! The activities are modeled for partner teachers in the classroom alongside their students. A curriculum guide, equipment kit and one-on-one support are provided to classroom teachers to teach the program to future students through the Blue Watershed Classrooms program. Continuing Education Units are available through our partnership with California State University East Bay.

- Learn the geography of the San Francisco Bay estuary and creek-bay-ocean connections.
- Create a 3-D model of the bay estuary ecosystem.
- Conduct a neighborhood storm drain pollution survey and clean-up.
- Lead a School-Wide Assembly on the importance of keeping the environment free of litter.
