



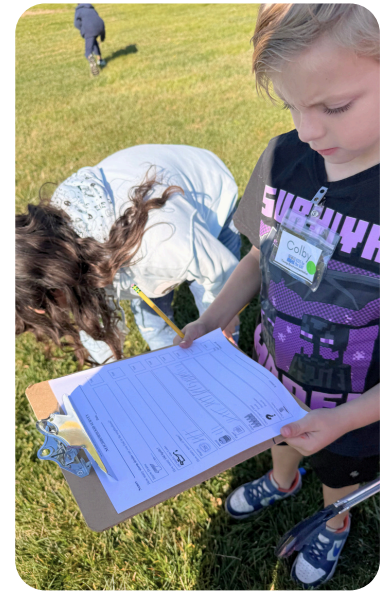

Everyone Is an Environmentalist!

Storm Drain Rangers Program 2024 – 2025 Year in Review

In the 2024-2025 School Year:

- **464 students** created informational posters to educate their communities about reducing stormwater pollution.
- Student Environmentalists cleaned up **5,827 pieces** of trash (**295 gallons**) from their neighborhoods.
- Student leaders made presentations and led assemblies to inspire **more than 500** audience members (peers, teachers, and school administrators) from **seven schools** to protect their watersheds.
- Over **460 families** engaged in interviews about stormwater pollution prevention with their students.
- **464 students** became Storm Drain Rangers and pledged to make behavior changes to help the watershed environment.
